The Coffin Works offer a characterful events space for hire in the heart of Birmingham, only a few minutes' walk from the train stations. Set in a grade II\* listed factory built in 1894, it is a unique setting for team meetings, conferences, concerts, festivals, theatre performances, private and corporate parties.



## The Green Room (meeting room)

Our modern meeting room seats comfortably up to 15 people Board Room Style, and 20 people Theatre Style, but can be set up in other formats.

We are stocked with the crockery and glassware you will need for your meeting or event as well as a kettle and hot water flasks which are available for you to use. You can either provide your own teabags, coffee and milk, or for a small charge we will supply hot drinks for your meeting. There are local sandwich shops close by who can provide catering and even deliver to the door.

As an extra feature, why not take a break from your meeting and have an exclusive group tour of the Newman Brothers Factory, which is part of the heritage attraction located at the Coffin Works.

This grade II\* listed factory and its contents tells the story of Newman Brothers, Birmingham's last coffin-furniture factory who operated from their



Fleet Street premises for over 100 years until 1998 when workers laid down their equipment, and walked out of the building for the very last time, leaving everything, including personal belongings behind.

The shelves and workbenches at Newman Brothers are full of original stock and tools of the trade. With the original machinery working again, you can experience how this old Jewellery Quarter firm once operated on a day-to-day basis, producing some of the world's finest coffin furniture, including the fittings for the funerals of Winston Churchill, Joseph Chamberlain and the Queen Mother. *Tours last approximately 1 hour. £5 / £4 (concessions) per head.*



## Outdoor Events

Our enclosed and paved historic Courtyard provides the space for outdoor evening events (and daytime on Mondays), with entrance through the Courtyard, and use of the toilet facilities.

If you also hire the Green Room, you also have access to tea and coffee and other meeting room facilities.
